

FINISHING ITEMS

Medium Grit Sandpaper

NOTE: Hardware pack may contain more hardware than what is needed to assemble.

A hammer and phillips head screw driver (not provided) will be needed for the assembly of this bench.


If the furniture is going to be placed on a concrete or tile patio, it should first be rinsed well to remove the sawdust that may cause some staining.

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1

On a clean flat surface, lay right leg assembly ① on its side mortise holes facing up. Locate the small label on the bottom of the seat that reads "front". With the front of the seat toward the front of the bench, line up and insert the front seat rail (\$) and seat (3) into the right leg assembly. Insert the large rounded pegs at the front of the seat into the front seat rail.




STEP 3

Insert the tenon of the bottom rail (6) into the mortise of the right arm assembly.




STEP 5

With a hammer, drive 8 dowels into the predrilled holes as shown. NOTE: Insert the tapered end of the dowels first. The dowels should be easily driven in flush. If there is strong resistance, do not force the dowel. Sand to smooth off areas around the dowel pins.




STEP 2

Place back seat rail 4 into position, holes facing inward. Insert the large rounded pegs at the back of the seat into the back seat rail.



STEP 4

Insert the left leg assembly 2 into the rest of the assembled parts. Secure the bottom rail by inserting a wood screw **1** through the under part of each leg as shown in figure 1 below.



STEP 6

Using a phillips head screwdriver, screw the remaining six wood screws ^(B) into the predrilled holes on the underside of the seat to attach the seat back, front rail and leg assemblies as shown.
