- ② Chaise Lounge Frame

  Quantity: 1




#### **HARDWARE**

- A Bolts

- B Cap Nuts Quantity: 8
- Axle Bolts

- D Large Washers Quantity: 2

- E Small Washers Quantity: 2
- Hex Nuts

## **FINISHING ITEMS**

Medium Grit Sandpaper

If the furniture is going to be placed on a concrete or tile patio, it should first be rinsed well to remove the sawdust that may cause some staining.


NOTE: A hammer and a phillips head screwdriver (not provided) will be needed for the assembly of this bench.

## **INSTRUCTIONS**


#### STEP 1

On a clean flat surface, lay seat assembly (4) flat on the ground. Using 4 bolts, (4) attach the back assembly (3) to the seat.



## STEP 3

Using two bolts, attach one arm ② to the leg and to the brace on the back assembly. (Arched cutout of the arms face inward.)




# STEP 4

Turn chaise to its upright position.



#### STEP 2

Carefully lay the chair on its side. Using three bolts, attach one leg (6) to the seat assembly. (Leg will be positioned with the arm brace facing upward and to the front of the seat assembly.) NOTE: Leave bolts slightly loose to help with alignment of the sofa seat assembly.
